Can you make the shadows bigger and smaller?</p> 	<p>Build a new tree house for "Plop" the Owl from our class novel," <i>The Owl who was Afraid of the Dark.</i> Use any materials you like and be ready to explain how you put the tree-house together.</p> 
<p>Make a list or draw pictures of objects around the house that produce light.</p> 	<p>Between <b>26-28 January</b> take part in the RSPB Big Garden Birdwatch 2019.</p> 	<p>Create a presentation eg. model, art, powerpoint, film, music etc about "Day &amp; Night" that you can share with the class in the last week of term.</p> 	<p>As it is World Book Day on <b>Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> March</b>, find a book, story or poem that you can bring in to school to share on the theme of day or night. <b>If you prefer parents, friends or family can come in to read these to the class at any point during that week.
