<p><b>Weekly - compulsory</b> Practise reading: Read for at least 15 minutes each day and complete a review of any completed books.</p>	<p><b>Weekly - compulsory</b> Practise spelling: Use the <i>Let's Have Fun with Spelling</i> booklet for ideas to practise your spelling words.</p>	<p><b>Weekly - compulsory</b> Practise maths basic facts to prepare for your weekly basic facts check.</p> 	<p><b>Weekly - compulsory</b> Play outside as much as you can!</p> 
<p><b>Mandarin</b> Research and create a slideshow about China. Focus on one aspect, i.e. language, food, history, culture, wildlife, etc.</p>	<p><b>Seasonal</b> Look for evidence of the changing seasons - what signs of autumn do you notice? Keep a journal to record your findings or do some time-lapse photography!</p>	<p><b>Maths/ICT</b> Complete a challenge on Sumdog.</p> 	<p><b>Literacy / ICT</b> Write a post on the class blog describing an activity or event you have taken part in outside of school.</p>
<p><b>Topic - Ancient Civilisations</b> Design and create your own clothing or headgear inspired by an ancient civilisation of your choice!</p>	<p><b>Topic - Ancient Civilisations</b> Do some research on what foods were eaten in ancient civilisations, and have a go at recreating an ancient recipe!</p>	<p><b>Topic - Ancient Civilisations</b> Create your own system of hieroglyphics and use them to write a letter to someone. Can they crack the code?</p>	<p><b>Topic - Ancient Civilisations</b> Build a model of an ancient building, for example an Egyptian pyramid, Roman amphitheatre, etc. You could use Lego or build it from junk.</p>
